We do charge a \$25.00 enrollment fee for processing your application, which is not refundable if you cancel too late. No refunds can be made after that date due to instructor and material obligations. No refunds will be given if a student withdraws once the class has begun. In the event that a course is not full enough to be held, those who did enroll will receive a full refund of the workshop tuition.
